WALK 1: BUDLEIGH SALTERTON - OTTERTON 10km, 3 -4 hrs, Moderate

Enjoy a scenic walk from Budleigh Salterton, through the Wetlands Nature Reserve, and along the South West Coast Path. Take in coastal views and peaceful countryside before stopping at Otterton Mill for a break at the café and farm shop.

WALK 2: EXMOUTH - SANDY BAY 10km, 3-4 hrs, Moderate

Follow the Exmouth Coastal Path, taking in stunning sea views and the striking **Jurassic red cliffs**, a **UNESCO World Heritage Site**. Stop for a break at Sandy Bay's café before continuing. At the end, relax with refreshments at Side Shore Café or Haydays Restaurant. N.B *This walk is tide-dependant.*

WALK 3: HALDON FOREST 4.5km, 2 - 3hrs, Moderate

Explore the Haldon Forest Raptor Trail, a scenic woodland walk with chances to spot birds of prey soaring above. Enjoy peaceful forest paths, fresh air, and beautiful viewpoints along the way. At the end, stop for refreshments at the On-site Café to recharge.

WALK 4: DARTMOOR/HAYTOR 10km, 2-3 hrs, Moderate -Difficult

This circular Dartmoor walk takes in the striking Haytor tors, the serene Quarry Lake, and breathtaking moorland scenery. Enjoy a tour of the tors, exploring the rugged beauty of this iconic landscape. At the end of the walk, relax and refuel with refreshments at Trago Mills.

WALK 5: DONKEY SANCTUARY - SIDMOUTH 5.5km, 2-3 hrs, Moderate

Start at the Donkey Sanctuary and enjoy a scenic walk with stunning coastal views of Lyme Bay. As you explore the path, take in the fascinating geology of the Triassic rocks, offering a glimpse into the area's ancient past. You'll also pass through Weston, adding even more charm to this coastal adventure before arriving in Sidmouth.
